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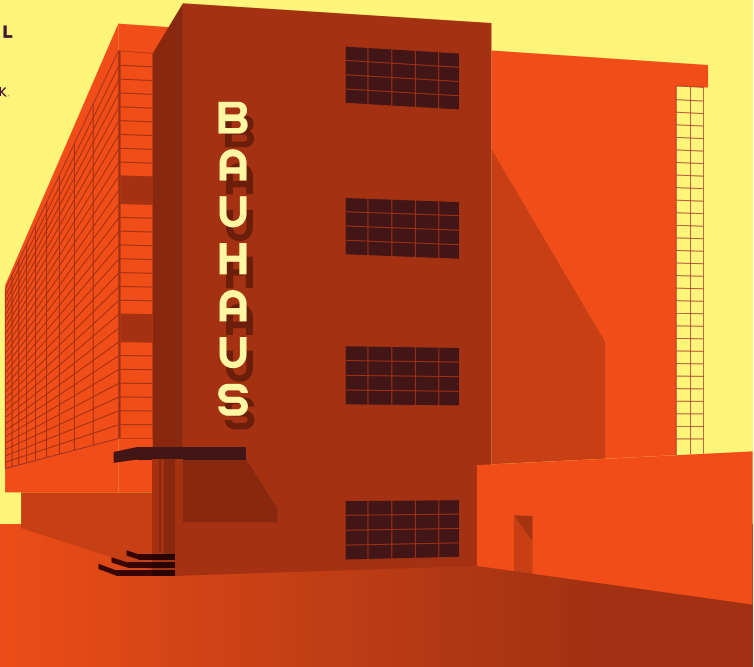

2018, Directors: Niels Bolbrinker, Thomas Tielsch, 90 min, subtitled

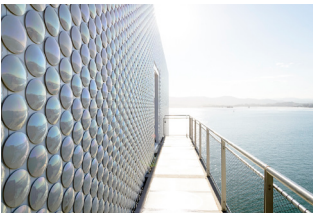
